- First come first basis.
- The previous school Cumulative Record is mandatory (except for Pre-Nursery & Nursery) along with interview with both parents and students.
- For Children with special needs, Assessment report from a certified Clinical Psychologist is a must. Both parent and child need to be present while the child is assessed by the administrator and the therapy team of the school too.

- Rs 1000/- concession for Children with Special Need (CWSN)
- If 4 children, then the 4th child admission is free
- For School staff, if 2 children, then one child's admission is free Monthly fees

- Naga Ed digital learning fee for class 9 & 10 Rs 200/- per month or Rs. 600/- to be paid every quarterly (March/June/Sept/Dec). Total payment for 1 year = Rs. 2400/- (Here, CWSN is exempted)
- Rs. 100/- less for CWSN in monthly fees
- If 3 or 4 children, the 3rd child or the 4th child monthly fee is Rs. 900/-
- For staff, if 2 children then one child monthly fee is free; and if 1 child, the monthly fee is half
- For full time Church workers, concessions will be the same as for CWSN (both in admission and monthly fees)
- Concession for genuine economically difficult children after assessment by the School Authorities.
